It is time for the SLL Slugger Showdown: We are rolling out a new fundraiser this year. It will be a ton of fun for the whole family. Please make sure that you and your parents review this packet for all of the information.

What is the SLL Slugger Showdown? The Slugger Show down is a unique and exciting batting tournament. It is also a fundraiser. This is your opportunity to help raise much needed funds while having a ton of fun and having the chance to win some really great prizes.

Why hold the Slugger Showdown?: The registration fees that your parent pay for your league participation only cover a portion of the year's expenses. We do receive funds from generous sponsors, but the rest must come from fundraising. The Slugger Showdown will help raise funds for necessary operational costs, gear and equipment. It will also raise money for our much needed Indoor Batting Facility. We are getting closer each year with Fundraising to make this facility a reality.

How does the Slugger Showdown Work? The Slugger Showdown will be held on Saturday June 7th. Your Team will be assigned a time when each player will face a set number of balls pitched by a pitching machine (except T-Ball). Your hits will score points based on how far you hit the ball, based on special scoring criteria. T-Ball will hit from a tee and the distance of each ball hit will be measured for their score. Each Player's points will be added up for the cumulative team score.

How do we earn Prizes? There will be several ways to win prizes. There will be one individual Fundraising Prize per combined (baseball and softball) division, One Top Team Fundraising Prize, and one Top Individual Fundraising Grand Prize for the highest fundraisers. There will also be Trophies awarded for each division in both Baseball and Softball for top Point Scorers and Top Cumulative Team Points scored—so encourage your team mates to participate!
